Born and raised in Lebanon, Mariana migrated to Sydney Australia at the age of 18. In 2007, she moved to Melbourne and quickly fell in love with the culinary culture that the city had to offer. At the age of 27, inspired by the story of 'Julia Child', Mariana decided to pursue her dream of becoming a chef. She travelled to France to follow the footsteps of her idol.

By 2014, Mariana had completed a comprehensive training program in 'Cuisine' and 'Pâtisserie' and graduated with a 'Grand Diplôme' from 'Le Cordon Bleu' in Paris.

Mariana then pursued another learning journey with 'Brasserie Thoumieux', under the mentorship of Chef 'Jean-Francois Piège'. Mariana's culinary career started in Paris at the Michelin-starred restaurant 'La Tour D'argent', under the supervision of Chef 'Yohan Lastre'.

Upon returning to Melbourne, she embarked on an exploration and experimentation journey using the finest local produce, ultimately enabling her to forge her own path within the culinary scene, finally founding 'Brûlée' in 2020.

Mariana provided great inspiration for our assembled students, parents and staff with particular emphasis on following our dreams to succeed in life.

Kwong Lee Dow Young Scholars Award

The Kwong Lee Dow Young Scholars Award is an academic enrichment program at the University of Melbourne designed to support high-achieving Victorian school students in realising their full potential. The program provides access to events, activities and resources to give students a head start into university. The program was established in 2007 and is named in honour of eminent scholar, leading educationalist and former Vice-Chancellor of the University of Melbourne, Professor Kwong Lee Dow. While in Year 10 up to 700 students are chosen each year on the basis of a school's endorsement and a student's academic performance and leadership skills. In Years 11 and 12, a student then has the opportunity to engage with the University and each other through an extensive program of events and activities.
